

**AGREEMENT ON STUDENT EXCHANGE**  
**BETWEEN**  
**CHULALONGKORN UNIVERSITY, FACULTY OF PHARMACEUTICAL SCIENCES, THAILAND**  
**AND**  
**<PARTNER UNIVERSITY>**

Chulalongkorn University, Faculty of Pharmaceutical Sciences in Thailand and the Faculty of ...partner university> in <country> agree to enter into the following terms of agreement with respect to furthering student exchange as follows:

**Article 1 Number of Students**

Subject to the other Articles herein contained, each participating university is entitled to a right to send students to the other institution for the purpose of studying and acquiring academic credits. The number of exchange students per year will not exceed two (2) for each university. Nevertheless, both universities agree to allow some flexibility in the number of exchange students upon mutual written consent.

**Article 2 Study**

Exchange students will register as full-time students in programmes that have been agreed upon by the student, the Home University and the Host University. The Host University will be responsible for both the academic supervision and assessment of the student. A report of each student's results will be sent to the Home University after the study period.

**Article 3 Academic Standard**

The Home University will be responsible for the selection of participating students, and for their academic and linguistic preparation. The Host University reserves the right to decline a student on academic grounds, or if other conditions within this agreement are not met.

**Article 4 Credit Transfer**

Credits awarded by the Host University will be transferred and recognised towards the student's degree at the Home University according to the Home University's rules and regulations. The Host University will send university transcripts of the study results to the Home University after the student has completed the study at the Host University.

**Article 5 Tuition and Fees**

Exchange students will pay regular tuition fee at their Home University. The Host University will waive tuition fee for students that take part in the exchange program.

Any student accepted outside this agreement will pay fees according to the regulations of the Host University.

**Article 6 Health Insurance**

The student is fully responsible for acquiring appropriate accident and medical insurance, according to the regulations of the Host University.

**Article 7 Accommodation**

Exchange students will be responsible for their own living costs, unless other arrangements have been agreed upon in writing. The Host University shall assist exchange students to find suitable housing. The payment of such housing, together with the payment for all travel, visa, medical insurance and subsistence costs, shall be the responsibility of the individual students participating in the program and neither institution shall be held liable for such charges and arrangements.

**Article 8 Personal Data Protection**

When personal data is collected, used, disclosed, or processed for purpose of this Agreement, Chula and <partner University> acknowledge that, to the extent applicable, they subject to the General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and the Personal Data Protection Act B.E. 2562 (2019) of Thailand.

**Article 9 Other Arrangements**

Detailed procedures for implementing the exchange programs which are not prescribed in this Agreement will be discussed and decided upon by both universities in writing at the appropriate time.

**Article 10 Dispute Resolution**

Any disagreements or disputes arising while implementing the Agreement will be discussed and settled by representatives from both universities.

**Article 11 Revision**

The clauses of this agreement may be revised or changed only upon written consent of both parties. The proposed alterations shall be presented by the parties and signed by the presidents of both universities.

**Article 12 Enforcement**

This Agreement shall remain in force for a period of five (5) years from the date of the last signature, on the understanding that it may be terminated by either party giving six (6) months' written notice to the other party. However, such termination shall not affect the completion of any program or activity underway at the time that the notice of termination is given. The Agreement may be extended by mutual written consent of the two parties.
